## A New Solar Shower for camping.



The 120 mile White Rim Trail in Utah's Canyon lands inspired the creation of Road Shower. On the White Rim trail, which is a vehicle supported mountain bike ride, we would ride into camp, dusty and dirty, and sweaty. We would fill up a solar shower....the plastic bag kind, and try to find a convenient place to hang it....not easy in the desert with few trees. Then, since it was already getting late, we would take a cold shower, since

there was not enough time to heat the water.

The year before we tried tying the solar showers to the top of our cars, but you can imagine, they didn't last long up there, and we lost one, and one got

punctured. Even when you have it tied up somewhere, the pressure isn't very good, and the nozzle is hard to work with soapy hands. Also, try filling them up by yourself. It is not easy.

So I set out to make a better solar shower. I came up with a car rack mounted pressurized solar shower. You mount it on your car rack, either Yakima or Thule, or use your factory rack with Yakima horizontal Mighty Mounts. It is as sturdy as mounting a bike rack.

The Road Shower will heat water on a warm sunny day. The sun enters the clear acrylic chamber and heats the black paint on the inside. The paint transfers the heat to the water. The water heats up as long as the tube is receiving sunlight from any angle. The water temperature rises 6-8 degrees per hour on a warm sunny day. If

your water starts at 60 degrees, it should be 90+ degrees in about 5-6 hours. On a hot sunny day the water can exceed 100 degrees. If you fill the Road Shower in the morning, it should be warm by mid afternoon. It heats up while you are driving down the highway, 4 wheeling, or parked somewhere. Just be sure it is in the sun. The Road Shower does not heat water as well if the outside temperature is below 70 degrees and/or the sun is low in the sky, or during cloudy days.

There is no need to hang it up...it is already elevated. You can raise one end and get pressure. Or better yet, you can pressurize it yourself with a bike pump or a CO<sub>2</sub> cartridge. Once pressurized, it will have enough pressure to take a shower and wash your hair.

The hose is a heavy duty garden hose with a commercial garden spray nozzle. The nozzle has several settings which includes shower and jet. The jet setting works

great for cleaning off muddy gear, such as bicycles, hiking boots, the dog, etc. When Road Shower is pressurized it can shoot a stream of water about



40 feet. It makes a great squirt gun.

It's easy to fill up. It takes 4 gallons of water. You can use 1 gallon jugs, or a hose, and pour water into the fill cap.

Joel pressurizes Road Shower with a CO<sub>2</sub> pump.

Road Shower holds enough water for two camping style showers. Under pressure, it shoots a steady stream for about 2 minutes and uses about 2 gallons. Pressurize again for 2 more minutes.

It also works great as a water dispenser at camp. You can do the dishes with it. Since all parts are non-toxic, you can even drink from it.

Here are some of the uses for Road Shower:

- Camping shower
- Cool off after a ride, or during a ride
- Shower for safari clients
- Clean your dog before they get in the car
- Clean your bike or your shoes
- Clean your hands after handling a big mess
- Rinse off after surfing, swimming in the ocean. Waterskiing or scuba diving.
- Set up a Road Shower at your remote cabin
- Use it at hunting camp
- Squirt your friends
- Rinse off after kayaking
- Rinse off your raft or kayak
